Basketball Victoria Participation License Fee

BV has now combined metro and country existing license pricing so is more equitable, affordable, transparent and fair, and covers all participation across the state during a 365-day period in any BV sanctioned competition.

Affiliation covers insurance and participation opportunities for players, provides services and insurance for clubs and associations, and development and management of the sport as a whole.

Cost:

- **\$29.00 per player for Junior (17 and under) annually / 365 days**
- **\$43.00 per player for Senior (18 and over) annually / 365 days**

Club Player Registration Costs

Each CADBA club will determine their own pricing structure each season. For more information regarding costs to join a club please contact your club administrator.

Fixture Requests

- Coaches of multiple teams will be accommodated (no games clash where possible).
- Players in multiple teams, permanent specific games time requests and team manager requests will be considered but are not guaranteed to be accepted.
- Fixture requests of any kind but be provided to the Competitions Manager with a minimum of 7 days notice to be considered.

Player Insurance

As part of registering within the Chelsea & District Basketball Association, all players are covered under Basketball Victoria insurance policy. If a player needs to make a claim, they can visit the below site:

Finals Eligibility

To be eligible to play finals a player must have taken the court and played at least 50% of scheduled games within that team within the season including grading games.

Domestic Club Clearances

CADBA has moved to electronic transfers using PlayHQ. Participants will be prompted to lodge a clearance when they go to register with their new club. The old club will receive a notification that a clearance has been requested and they have 7 days to action before it is automatically approved.

Referee Program

The CADBA Referee Program has grown in the number of officials by just over 33 % since the return from COVID. This is due to the hard work of our new Referee Advisor and Referee Coaches, but we still have a way to go to ensure all games are fully resourced. Basketball Victoria have reported that the current overall shortage across the state sits at 30%. CADBA currently have another 12 officials working through a beginner course and you can expect to see them to progress from white to green shirt in late August/early September and be graded to C for the beginning of the new Summer season. CADBA is almost able to have the return of off court supervisors every night. Having off court supervisors who assist the referees in their development is a crucial aspect to our program and we look forward to delivering this very shortly. Supervisors can often be seen at venues throughout our competitions encouraging and supporting referees. Our referees are often players, teenagers, adults, coaches, life members of the sport who are giving back and helping us run a competition.

It is important we all play our part in helping our referees develop by allowing them to referee the game. If you have queries on game days, a coach or player may politely speak to a referee. Spectators are not to approach referee's and must adhere to the Spectator Code of Conduct.

Scoring

Every team must provide at least one scorer for each game which is often organized by a team manager. There are two roles on the score bench:

1. The game clock. This is the visual for players, spectators, and coaches to see score.
2. The electronic scoring device. This is the official tracking, and where results are submitted from at the end of each day. It is important the device is correct upon completion of the game.

Results

Not all venues have internet / WIFI services available therefore not all results will automatically upload to our website. CADBA offices will ensure all results are loaded by midday the following day.

Teammo Online Payment Platform for Independent Teams

CADBA use Teammo to collect and manage match fees and forfeits. Teammo is an online sports payments platform to collect, manage and report on payments from teams and individuals.

Teammo will also be used to manage forfeit submissions. If your team is unable to play, a forfeit needs to be submitted and paid for via your Teammo account. Once a forfeit has been submitted and paid for, Teammo sends out SMS notifications to Chelsea Basketball and the teams affected.

As a team manager, you also have the option to use Teammo to collect money from your team members. Money collected is sent to your nominated bank account.
