CADBA RETURN TO BASKETBALL: COVID SAFE PLAN

as of 17 June 2021



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PURPOSE

If any below apply to you, stay home:

- Experiencing any cold or flu like symptoms
- Been in direct contact with a known case of COVID-19 in the previous 14 days
- Travelled internationally in the previous 14 days
- A high risk person from a health perspective, including; the elderly or those with pre-existing medical health conditions

- To comply with COVID safety requirements set out by the Victorian Government
- Communicate industry specific health, safety and hygiene protocols to be implemented during CADBA activities
- To ensure the safety of staff, volunteers, spectators and participants

FACTORS

CADBA SANITATION PLAN

Measures that CADBA will take to ensure the health and safety of our community

01

SCORE BENCH

All equipment must be sanitized at the end of every game by referee

02

TEAM BENCHES

Benches must be sanitized at the end of every game by Biosafety Officer

03

HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitization is mandatory upon entry and exit of CADBA venues

04

BASKETBALLS

Game Balls will be sanitized by Venue Supervisor. Referees will need to sanitize basketball in between games

05

REFEREES

Referees are to sanitize before game, at halftime/quarter breaks and timeouts and to remind participants to socially distance

VENUE FACILITIES

CADBA venues (Bonbeach Stadium, Flinders College - Carrum Downs and Patterson River Secondary College) will have restricted access to certain facilities to adhere to social distance guidelines

CANTEEN

The canteen will be closed until further notice. Once re-opened, socially distanced markers will be placed for when customers are waiting in line

WATER FOUNTAINS

Water fountains will not be available until restrictions are eased further. Please bring your own water bottles and do not share your drink bottle with anyone

CHANGE ROOMS

Change rooms will not be available to use until restrictions are eased further. Please come dressed and ready for your game and/or training

REF ROOMS

Ref rooms will not be available to use until restrictions are eased further. Please come dressed and ready for your game. Personal items can be handed to the Stadium Manager for safe keeping

SPECTATOR GUIDELINES

As of 17 June 2021 and per Basketball Victoria's Return-to-Sport Guidelines

TRAININGS

- Team staff – 1 x coach, team manager & scorer
- 1 x parent/guardian per player
- Team Manager and scorer are part of the team, not as a parent
- Siblings cannot attend

COMPETITIONS

- Team staff – 1 x coach, team manager & scorer
- 1 x parent/guardian per player
- Team Manager and scorer are part of the team, not as a parent
- Siblings cannot attend

ENTRY AND EXIT PROCEDURES

Enter and exit CADBA venues using the posted signage to reduce unnecessary transmission opportunities

UPON ENTRY

- Wait in carpark until 10 mins before your game/training
- Sign in using QR code at the door
- Sanitize your hands and ball

UPON EXIT

- Sanitize your hands and ball
- Leave out of designated exit
- Do not congregate in car park

HOW YOU CAN STOP THE SPREAD

CADBA asks that you self-regulate your behavior by actioning the following

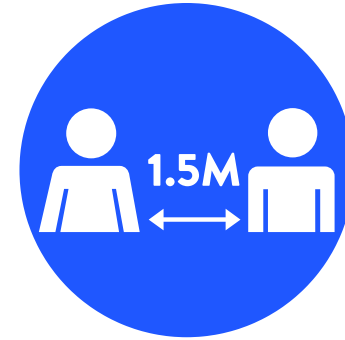

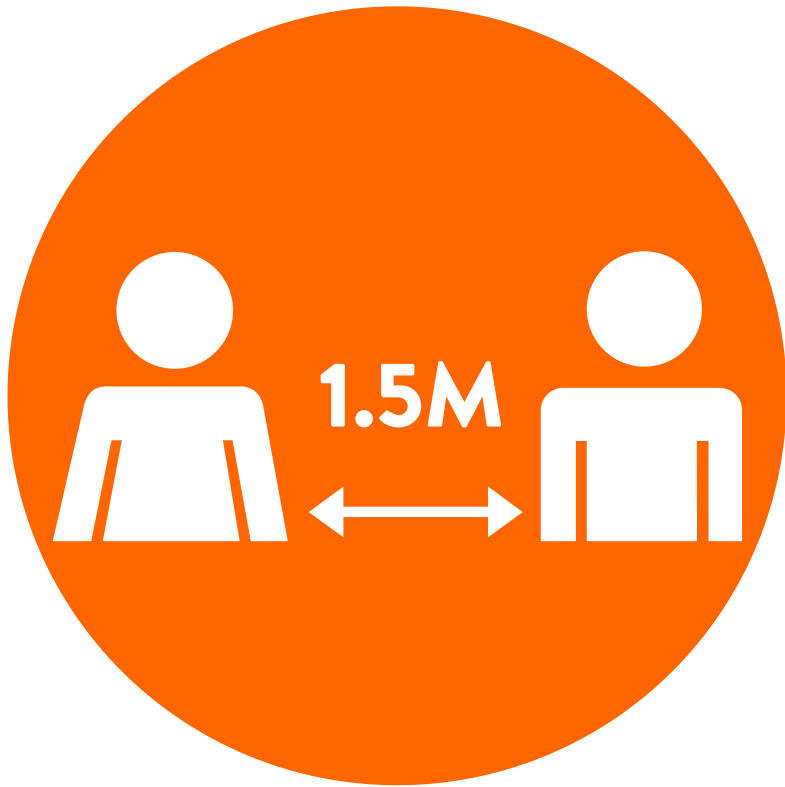

SOCIAL DISTANCING



- Keep 1.5 metres away from people you don't live with
- Restrain from shaking hands, hugging or kissing as a greeting
- Be patient and courteous in lines - give people their 1.5m
- Wash hands regularly (20 seconds using soap and water)
- Cover your mouth & nose with a tissue/your elbow when coughing/sneezing
- Avoid touching eyes, nose & mouth
- Stay at home if you're unwell or showing symptoms of COVID-19

FACE MASKS AND QR CODE



- Mandatory indoors as per Victorian Government requirements
- All patrons aged 12 years and over are required to carry and wear a fitted mask if social distancing cannot be adhered to
- At any time when not participating, players may wear a mask if they feel necessary



- Prior to entry to any CADBA venue, sign in using the Victorian Government's QR Code for contact tracing purposes
- Manual sign in sheets will be on-site but we prefer and encourage everyone to utilize the QR Code system

BIOSAFETY OFFICERS (BSO)

All CADBA Biosafety Officers, Referees, Staff, Rep Coaches and Rep Team Managers are required to complete DHHS endorsed Infection Control Training

RESPONSIBILITIES

The BSO;

- Will complete venue checklist prior to commencement of training or games
- Will complete venue checklist and record the number of participants within the venue during each allocated training or game timeslot
- Will ensure that equipment is sanitized in accordance with the RTS Guidelines
- When required, will ask patrons to separate, or leave the venue to comply with the RTS Guidelines
- Will return a signed checklist at the end of their shift
- Will report any participant refusing to follow reasonable requests to the Competitions Manager of the club or association

PLAYERS & TEAM STAFF

If experiencing symptoms; been in contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 or traveled internationally in the past 14 days; or are high-risk with pre-existing conditions; STAY HOME

- All players, coaches and team managers must be fully registered and insured prior to arriving at the venue and ensure all details are correct on PlayHQ
- Team payments must be completed by 1 person only (cashless preferred)
- Drink bottles and towels allowed on player benches, as long as 1.5m apart
- Players are to use the hand sanitizer provided on the court score benches at the beginning of each half, after timeouts and at the end of the game. They must also use this when returning from the court from any substitution
- No high fives or shaking of hands. Team benches and huddles must follow social distancing guidelines
- All basketballs are to be sanitized with the wipes available at score benches before use

REFEREES*

All CADBA Referees are required to complete DHHS endorsed Infection Control Training and to comply with/enforce this CADBA COVID Safe Plan

BEFORE PLAY

- Sanitize score bench, iPad, arrows, etc.
- Collect sanitized game ball from the Doorkeeper/Venue Supervisor
- Enter/confirm team players, coaches and team managers into PlayHQ
- Instruct each team to use hand sanitizer on entering the court, throughout the game during substitutions, timeouts and halftime breaks
- Together with the coaches, remind teams not to high five, and to keep social distancing in team huddles and bench seating

AFTER PLAY

- 20 minutes is to be put on the clock
- Confirm game on the iPad
- Sanitize iPad, arrows, score bench, etc.
- Sanitize game ball with sanitizer wipes

** If Referees have an individual who is not complying with the CADBA COVID Safe Plan and Return-to-Sport guidelines, they are to bring it to the attention of the Biosafety Officer immediately*
